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1. Characteristics of ARC Academy

1. Communication Skills Trained by Skilled Teachers

Since opening our school in 1986, ARC Academy has provided Japanese language education focusing on communication skills acquisition. ARC Academy Kyoto provides the Study Abroad Course, aimed at students who wish to learn Japanese systematically for a long term to pursue higher education or to find a job in Japan, and the Intensive Course, where students can learn useful Japanese in a communicative way in a short term.

4. Scholarships

Students have access to multiple scholarships after their entrance: the "Program for the promotion of the admission of international students" (former "Scholarship of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology for international students"), the "LSH Scholarship", the "Kyoritsu Maintenance Scholarship", as well as ARC Academy's own scholarship program (special scholarship for students who have high attendance rates) are available for students after their entrance.

Field trips and extra activities including outdoor classes, sports day, speech competitions, etc. are available every semester. Courses and activities in class will enrich and enhance the students' study abroad experience.

Requirements	The student must be minimum 16 years old and shall obtain the visa to stay in Japan on his/her own.

- (1) **Goal:** These courses will allow students to acquire Japanese systematically and accurately, and fulfill each personal studying purpose. Levels are divided into Beginner, Elementary, Intermediate, and Advanced. A comprehensive approach to speaking, listening, reading, and writing allows students to improve these 4 skills together.
- (2) Requirements for admission: Healthy in mind and body. Study Abroad Course applicants are required at least to have graduated from high school. Applicants under 16 years old must contact the school before applying to the Intensive Course.
- (3) Study Abroad Course: The minimum duration of our Study Abroad Course is 6 months, while the maximum is 2 years. Those who wish to go on to higher educational institutes must complete Study Abroad Course in March. The visa (Eligibility status) students are issued with ARC Academy Kyoto's acceptance certificate is Student visa. Students can extend the duration of their visa, if needed, during their enrollment period.
- (4) Intensive Course: Students must apply for their short-term visa to the nearest Japanese Consulate. Specific countries are under visa waiver.
- (5) Courses opening: 4 times per year. (January, April, July, October)
- (6) 2020 Courses Schedule: 1 term=3 months *Schedule might be subject to change.

(7) Class hours: Classes are made up of 4 periods a day and each period is 45 minutes long. A placement test will be conducted upon entrance, to determine class division. Grades taken during the term will determine the following homeroom. Class hours differ according to the Japanese level. Class hours are as follows:

- $\textbf{(8) Holidays:} \ \ \text{Saturdays, Sundays, public/summer/end-of-term holidays, and holidays set by the Headmaster.}$
- (9) Part-time job: Any job performed under a short-term visa is prohibited by law in Japan. A student with a Student visa can take a part-time-job only with a specific permission from the local Immigration Bureau; maximum working hours is 28 hours per week (school regulation sets at 8 hours per day the maximum working hours during end-of-term holidays). However, even with the permission from the Immigration Bureau, it is prohibited to work in indecent businesses or in the sex related industry. Also, a certain level of fluency in Japanese is required for part-time jobs. We will support students to find a part-time job and will help practice for a job interview.
- (10) Illegal Acts and Behaviors: A student who disobeys the law or school rules, or fails to pay tuition fee by the deadline will be ordered to leave Japan by the Headmaster. Those who are absent for a long term from school or disobey the Headmaster's instructions will also be ordered to leave Japan. Students must have over 90% attendance rate while enrollment in school

(2) Required Documents for a short-term visa

Necessary documents differ depending on the applicant's nationality. Please consult your closest Japanese Consulate of Embassy.

(3) Payment

The applicant or their proxy are asked to pay the Application, Registration and Tuition fees either directly to the Kyoto school or to the bank accounts specified below. Also, credit card and local currency are available through Flywire. Students who arranged accommodation through ARC Academy, are expected to pay the accommodation fee together with the tuition.

① Bank accounts for remittance

The sender's name on the bank transfer must be the same as the applicant's. When tuition fee has been transferred, please send the proof of payment to the school by email. Please note that applicants must pay the bank transfer charges. If there appears a difference between requested and received amount due to bank transfer charge, students will be asked to pay the difference upon entrance into ARC Academy.

4. Study Abroad Course Application Documents

◆Remarks on submission of necessary documents:

- (1) All documents must be original.
- (2)Fill out ARC Academy original application form from sheet A to C.
- (3) Submitted documents will not be returned. If there are any documents that must be returned, please let us know when making the application.
- All certifications should be issued within 3 months before submission.
- (5) All non-Japanese documents must be submitted with Japanese translation.
- (6) Be sure to write your telephone, fax number and e-mail address on Form A, so that the school can contact you any time concerning your application.
- (7)The school may ask you for additional documents other than the ones documents listed below.
- (8) Providing false information will result in cancellation of admission and the student will be ordered to leave Japan.

◆Documents concerning applicants:

*①, ②, ③, ⑥, ⑦must be submitted in any case. Other documents are necessary depending on your nationality.

- Diploma or Certificate and transcript from the highest school If you are currently a student, make sure to submit the certificate of enrollment from the school you are attending. Your diploma will be returned to you after your COE is issued by the immigration Bureau. Vietnamese applicants need to submit VJEEC authentication certificate.
- **Certificate of applicant's family** Family registration, Birth certificate, Residence certificate, etc.
- Certificate of Japanese language proficiency Certificate of JLPT, J-TEST, NAT, etc., or certificate issued by a Japanese language institution which states your hours of study. If the result of your Japanese proficiency exam has not been issued yet, submit the copy of your examination admission slip.
- Photocoy of your passport If you have a passport, provide a photocopy of the page with the passport number and your name. Students with emigration and immigration history to Japan must submit photocopies of pages with emigration and immigration stamps and visa pages.
- Photos (3cm×4cm) 4pieces Photos must have been taken within 3 months (front, head uncovered) before the application. Glue 1 photo to the upper right-hand photo colum on application form, sheet A. All photos must be the same and your name must be written on the back.

◆Documents concerning sponsors who are bearing applicant's study and living expenses:

*①, 2 must be submitted. Other documents are necessary depending on your nationality.

- 1 Guarantee for Bearing Study and Living Expenses (form C) (hand written by sponsor)
- Bank Account Balance Certificate Bank account of the person bearing study and living expenses, within 3 months before the application.
- 3 Certificate expressing how the funds were gathered Description, Copy of bankbook, etc.
- Certificate of Employment Document specifying the company, group, etc. where the sponsor is currently employed. If the sponsor is the board member of the company, submit the certificate of company registration, etc.
- (5) **Income/Tax Certificate** Provide past 3 years documentation proving the sponsor's income.
- Certificate of sponsor's family Official Family registration, Birth certificate, Residence certificate, etc.
- Certificate explaining the relationship between the applicant and the sponsor Family registration, Birth certificate, Residence certificate, etc., issued officially. When the sponsor is not a close family member, provide a letter explaining the reason why the sponsor will bear all the expenses addressed to Immigration Bureau. (A4 size, free format, with signature)

■Course Fees

- ① Application fee and Registration fee that have already been paid cannot be refunded.
- ② If you wish to cancel your enrollment, please notify it the latest 1 day prior to the entrance ceremony, in written form. ARC Academy will refund the tuition fee after Acceptance Certificate and the Certificate of Eligibility have been returned. (once you have entered Japan, the refund will be made after you have provided to ARC Academy proof of your return to your country.) In case your visa application was denied at the Japanese consulate, you would be asked to submit to ARC Academy Acceptance Certificate and the copy of your passport page with the visa denial stamp. Tuition fee for 6-month school term cannot be refunded in any reason of cancellation after entrance ceremony/placement test/orientation.
- ③ Regarding withdrawal after entrance (where "entrance" is considered as the first day the student attends classes or takes part to a school event, such as the entrance ceremony/placement test/orientation.), the tuition fee for 6-month school term cannot be refunded. Regarding withdrawal before completing the period you enrolled for, you must submit an official withdrawal notification with the reason within the end of the school term (4 times in a school year, in June, September, December, and March) under your sponsors' agreement. With the permission of headmaster, ARC Academy will refund the remaining tuition fee corresponding to the school terms you have not attended yet in instalments of 3 months. Moreover a 20% cancellation charge will be deducted from the refundable amount.
- (4) Refund will be back transferred to you after deducting money transfer charge, after you have provided to ARC Academy either proof of your return to your home country, the entrance into higher education in Japan or your visa status change in Japan.
- (5) No refunds are made in case students are expelled for violating the law or school regulations.
- If you wish to extend the period of your enrollment, you must declare in a "Student Information Sheet" we give you on the first month of each term, by the deadline. Tuition fee for Japanese class extension is as follows: ¥180,000 (3 months), ¥360,000 (6 months), ¥540,000 (9 months), ¥720,000 (1year). Course extension may be rejected, depending on the number of students in a certain class and your attendance record. Please be reminded that you are not allowed to take the Study Abroad Course for more than 2 years.
- Tuition fees must be paid within the deadlines set by the school. Please meet the deadlines for payment, otherwise you will not be allowed to take any class.

6. Life in Japan

1. Living expenses

Living expenses (food, housing, utilities etc.) range from approximately \$\pm\$100,000 to \$\pm\$150,000 per month. When you sign a housing contract, you might be requested to pay, besides rent, a deposit and a non-refundable deposit (key money). In addition, a commuter pass is necessary for the daily commute to school. (Students are not able to get any student commuter pass.) We suggest that you bring at least \$\pm\$400,000~\pm\$500,000 for living expenses for the first few months. Many students take part-time jobs; remember that the hourly wage in Kyoto area is around \$\pm\$1,000.

2. National Health Insurance / JLIC Foreign Student Plan Insurance

Students holding a Student Visa will be issued a Residence Card upon arrival in Japan. Within 14 days since your address has been decided, you must submit the "Moving - in Notification" to the nearest city hall or ward office and apply for National Health Insurance. Students who applied for National Health Insurance can use JLIC Foreign Student Plan Insurance system through ARC Academy. JLIC Insurance covers the medical fees not reimbursed by the National Health Insurance (30%) for any sickness or injury the student suffers during his/her enrollment at ARC Academy. (The deductible is \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3},000\) per case) Students with short-term visa cannot apply for National Health Insurance, but can apply for JLIC Insurance after admission.

3. Housing

ARC Academy can provide information on accommodations and homestay with easy access to Kyoto school. Please contact us for details. Please note that in case the housing facilities quota are reached, we might not be able to meet your request.


