## Application made outside Japan

[Before the course begins]

Cancellations must be notified in writing by e-mail. Please contact us again if you do not hear from us after your notification. ## Application made in Japan


Those who have eligibility for more than 3 months stay, with over 2 months of course enrollment, and have enrolled in a course which is more than 50,000yen (tuition fee).

#### [Before the course begins]

Regarding registration fee and tuition fee, 15,000yen is deducted as a cancellation fee and the remainder shall be refunded. When the already-paid fee is less than the cancellation fee, the balance must be paid.

### [After the course begins]

Regarding registration fee and tuition fee, the total of registration fee and already-attended tuition fee are deducted from payment and the remainder shall be refunded. 20% of the remainder (max.50,000yen) is also deducted as a cancellation fee.
